Bike-Quip: Installation Guidelines - ST1300 Sat Nav Mount

Please read BEFORE attempting to fit this accessory.

<u>Preparation</u>: Protect the front end of your fuel tank with a towel or similar. Spray the two existing handlebar fixings (the two which are closest to your fuel tank) with WD40 or similar, as they can be very difficult to remove.

- 1. With a small 'sharp' ended screwdriver, prise off the 2 chromed plastic screw covers. Be gentle in this task as these plastic covers can break quite easily. Put these to one side for use later.
- 2. Remove the two screws you have now exposed and put these safely to one side in case you ever want to remove your Sat Nav Mount.
- 3. Your Sat Nav Mount is sent to you with two transit nuts. Remove these nuts and dispose of them as they are not required.
- 4. Keep the Sat Nav Mount assembled in the same way as you received it. Carefully screw each fixing in to place carefully thus avoiding getting a cross threaded problem! Do each screw up a little at a time until you have a secure fixing on each screw. During this whole fixing procedure make certain that each of the 2 s/steel spacers are seated squarely at both their tops and bottoms.
- 5. Replace the two chromed plastic covers. If necessary, push these plastic covers fully home with a small piece of square or round wood (about 1/4" diameter) to avoid damaging them.
- 6. Some people remove the sat nav ball and apply Loctite to its thread to reduce the chances of it being stolen.
